Shipping Season

The shipping season begins in early May and continues through September. We do not ship plants until they have come out of dormancy. We ship on Mondays and Tuesdays to ensure that plants will not be sitting in a warehouse over the weekend. We send healthy, happy plants and want you to be happy too.

If there is a specific time period you do not want to receive your plants, let us know. We will try to accommodate your schedule.

Due to the variability in Wisconsin's weather from year to year, Kinnickinnic Natives reserves the right to hold orders until plants are ready for shipment and weather conditions are favorable for shipment.

Delivery

We only ship orders to states located in the UPS Zone 1 and 2, which includes: WI, MN, IA, IL, IN, MI, ND, and SD via UPS Ground delivery. We specialize in local eco-type native perennials and prefer to sell locally.

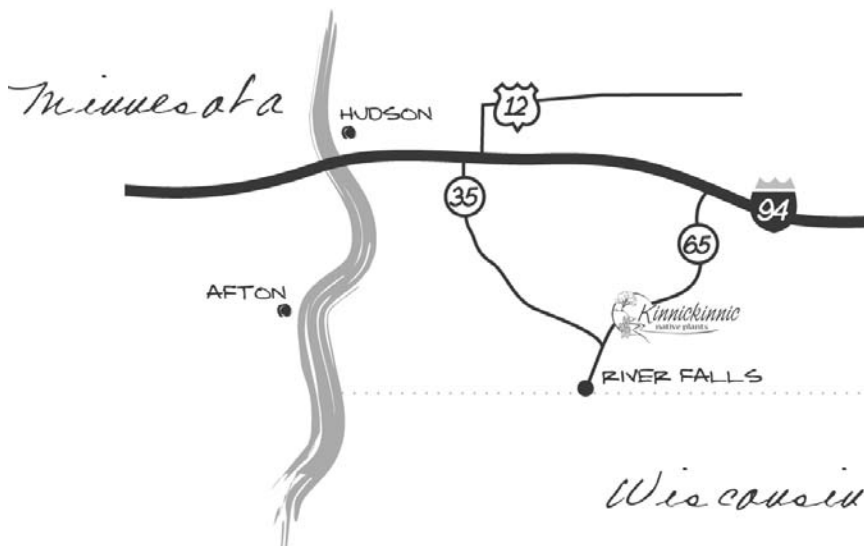
